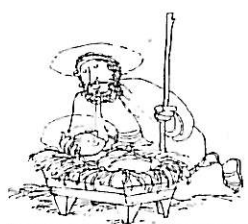

**Thirty Third Sunday in Ordinary Time – 14 November, 2010**

Dear parishioners of St. Joseph's, St. Patrick's, Stella Maris and all visitors,

I've had no feed-back about my proposal to change the Christmas Midnight Mass from St. Joseph's, Waihi to Stella Maris, Waihi Beach. If you have strong feelings please let's know.

It is just two weeks now until we begin praying and singing the new words of the People's Parts of the Mass. This will be the first step. The full English text of the Roman Missal- including Eucharistic Prayers, Prefaces and Collects- will be launched at Pentecost, 2011.

The translation process that provided these new words was intent upon three significant results: more theological precision in vocabulary and syntax; more scriptural allusions and more consistency across all language groups. It will not be easy to let go of the familiar and comfortable words that we have prayed and sung at Mass for the last 40 years. There is no doubt that these new texts will require our full concentration until we have learnt to use the new words. But they have a real potential to draw us into a deeper appreciation of the meaning and the beauty of the Mass. I am sure you will come to love them as well!

On Monday, at 5.30pm, all the priests of the Diocese will gather with Bishop Denis at the Cathedral for a special Mass to celebrate the Jubilees of Fr. Anton Timmerman (65), Fr. John Bergin (55), Fr. Peter Flannery (50), Fr. Peter Carde (45) and Fr. Nic Hoogeveen (40). Everyone is welcome.

On Tuesday at 12.00pm the annual Mass for the deceased clergy of the Diocese will be held at St. Michael's, Ohaupo. Once again, all are welcome.

As I intend to stay over in Hamilton on Monday night **there will be no 9.00am Mass at St. Joseph's on Tuesday.** There will be a Communion Service.

On Wednesday the Catholic Women's League will have their Christmas Luncheon. On Friday our School Staff will follow suit. Enjoy!!

Bishop John Cunneen, the former Bishop of Christchurch, has gone to his eternal reward after a lifetime of sublime service to the Lord. Bishop John's Requiem will be on Wednesday at St. Mary's Church, Manchester Street, Christchurch. Later he will be laid to rest in the Cathedral of the Blessed Sacrament; a building he loved so dearly.

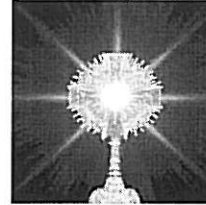
