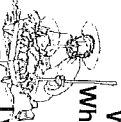

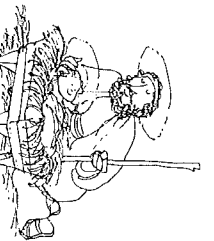

Palm Sunday – 17 April, 2011

Dear parishioners of St. Joseph's, St. Patrick's, Stella Maris and all visitors,

And so we begin the most sacred week of the Church's Year. We accompany Jesus from His entry into Jerusalem on a donkey today, through to the Last Supper on Thursday and then stand before the Cross, in sorrow, on Friday. On Sunday everything changes as we celebrate our Beloved Lord's glorious resurrection. May the week bring you great blessings.

On Tuesday, Mass at Waihi will be at 8.00am to enable me to be on time for the day of Recollection for Priests in Hamilton later in the morning.

The Chrism Mass will be at the Cathedral at 7.00pm. During the Mass, we, the priests of the Hamilton Diocese, will gather with Bishop Denis to renew our commitment to Priest-hood. If you choose to come to the Mass, know that you are most welcome to attend a meal in the Cathedral Centre at 5.45pm; especially put on for those who come from a distance.

Wednesday: Fr. Albert will have arrived at Whangamata and will say Mass at 9.00am. I will celebrate Mass at Waihi at the same time. At 7.00pm, Rite II Reconciliation will be held at Whangamata.

Holy Thursday: No morning Masses.
The Mass of the Lord's Supper will be at 7.00pm at both St. Joseph's and St. Patrick's.

Good Friday: Stations of the Cross will be recited at St. Joseph's, Waihi at 10.00am. The Commemoration of the Passion will be at both St. Joseph's and at St. Patrick's at 3.00pm.

Holy Saturday: The Easter Vigil will be celebrated at Stella Maris, Waihi Beach and St. Patrick's, Whangamata, at 7.00pm.

At the ceremony at Stella Maris we will have the great joy of welcoming our Elect into full communion with the Church.

Easter Sunday: Masses of the Lord's Resurrection will be held at 8.00am at Waihi Beach; 9.00am at Whangamata and 10.00am at Waihi. At Waihi Beach and Waihi please bring flowers for children to flower the Cross.

Easter Monday (Anzac Day). There will be Mass at 8.00am at St. Joseph's, Waihi.

I hope all teachers and students have a restful and happy School holidays.

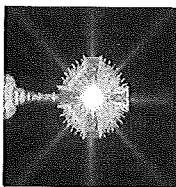
