The Body and Blood of Christ – 26 June, 2011

Dear parishioners of St. Joseph's, St. Patrick's, Stella Maris and all visitors,

Today we celebrate the feast of 'Corpus Christi'- 'The Body of Christ'. It is a day when we thank the Lord from the depths of our hearts for the wonder and intimacy of Holy Communion.

There will be no Masses at St Joseph's this Monday and this Tuesday. There will be Communion Services.

On Friday, (July 1<sup>st</sup>), the Feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, Catholic Churches throughout the world will join in celebrating the 60<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the Ordination of Pope Benedict XVI as a priest. Mass will be at the usual time, 11.00am, at St. Joseph's. We will be especially praying for our beloved Pope.

Work on redeveloping St. Patrick's, Whangamata, will begin on Monday, July 11<sup>th</sup>. Saturday, July 9<sup>th</sup>, therefore, will be our last Saturday night at St. Patrick's for some months. An alternative venue for the Saturday evening Masses is soon to be finalized. The Wednesday morning Masses will be celebrated in the Parish House, adjoining the Church.

A letter has arrived from the Bishops of New Zealand making it clear that Mass offerings- the gift freely given by the faithful to a priest for the celebration of Mass for a specific intention- is to be limited to \$10. If you choose to give a Mass offering, I will always accept it however be assured that I will offer Masses for your specific intentions on request; with or without Mass offerings.

Fr. Gerard Paterson has stepped back from being parish priest of the three Rotorua Parishes in order to be caregiver to his ailing parents. He will assist Fr. Demetrio pastorally in the Matata/ Whakatane parish. The new parish priest for the Rotorua parishes is Fr. Mark Field. The search continues to find another priest to assist Fr. Mark in his role as pastor of those busy parishes.

Congratulations to Phillipa and Kelly Ellard and Margaret Holden who have formally been recognized by Bishop Denis as a Catholic community in the Hamilton Diocese. The name they have taken for their community is 'The Children of Hope Catholic Community'.

Farewell and God Bless to our beloved Inge Forster who returns to her homeland- ash clouds permitting- this coming week. And thank-you, Inge, for your marvelous contribution to Parish life in Whangamata over the last 15 years.

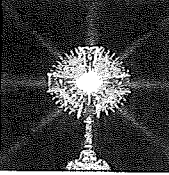
